

NON OFFICIAL TRANSLATION

1. The establishment of a Special Program for the Development of photovoltaic systems up to 10 kW_p, hereinafter the Program, for buildings used for residence or buildings that house very small enterprises, lasting until 31.12.2019.
2. The Program is related to photovoltaic systems for the generation of power that is injected into the Network, which are installed on a room on the roof of a building, or the roof itself, including balcony roofs.
3. This Program applies for the entire country, with the exception of islands not interconnected with the country's mainland System.
4. Entitled to be included in the Program are natural non-professional persons, and natural or legal professional persons, that fall under the very small enterprise category, who own the space where the photovoltaic system is installed.

1. The Netting Agreement for a photovoltaic system (hereinafter Netting Agreement) is concluded between the owner of the photovoltaic system and PPC S.A. [Public Power Corporation S.A.] or other supplier which is supplying the power for demands of the building where the photovoltaic system is installed, with a twenty five (25) year term, starting on the date the photovoltaic system connection is activated. This Agreement is mutually agreed on a fixed reference price which corresponds to the year on which it is concluded, pursuant to paragraph 3 herein, under the condition that the connection of the photovoltaic system will be activated within six (6) months from the conclusion of the Netting Agreement. If this is not the case, the reference price shall be the price that corresponds to the year

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on which the photovoltaic system's connection was activated.

3. The price of the electric power generated from the photovoltaic system and injected into the network is set at 0.55 Euros/kVh for Netting Agreements concluded in years 2009, 2010, 2011. The price is decreased by 5% each year for Netting Agreements concluded in the period from 1.1.2012 until 31.12.2019.

4. The price mutually agreed upon in the Netting Agreement is readjusted each year by 25% of the consumer price index of the previous year, as this is determined by the National Statistical Service of Greece or the competent body each time. If the price of the above adjustment is less than the average limit price of the System, as it was shaped in the previous year, increased by 40%, the pricing is carried out based on the average limit price of the System of the previous year, increased by the corresponding coefficient above.

6. The generated power is measured at the same time as the consumed power. Generated power is the power generated by the photovoltaic system minus any power the system might absorb from the Network for its own demands. The crediting of the generated electric power follows the billing cycles for the consumed power. The settlement is carried out by PPC S.A. or any other supplier, which for this reason includes in the power consumption bill of the owner of the photovoltaic system a relevant credit entry. In this case this bill is equivalent to a purchase invoice for the power supplied by the owner of the photovoltaic system. At the same time, PPC S.A., or another supplier, charges DESMIE [Hellenic Transmission System Operator S.A.] which keeps the Special Account under the provisions of article 40, Law 2773/1999, for the total amount of the expenditure for the settlement of all owners of photovoltaic systems that correspond to it on a monthly basis and attaches a relevant detailed statement.

1. The photovoltaic system is connected to the low voltage distribution Network. For the connection, PPC S.A., as Network Operator, uses the line that supplies power for the demands of the property where the photovoltaic system is installed, where technically possible. In any case, the connection corresponds to an existing supply number of the property of the owner of the photovoltaic system.

2. For the connection of the photovoltaic system, an application is submitted to PPC S.A. (Local Service, Region), as System Operator.

3. After the application and documents of paragraph 2 are submitted, PPC S.A., as Operator of the Network, examines the request giving it priority, and within twenty (20) days makes a Connection Offer to the interested owner of the photovoltaic system, that includes the description and the expenditure for the connection works, which is valid for three (3) months after the date of its issue. PPC S.A. supplies to the owner of the photovoltaic system any information requested for documenting the need for the implementation of the specific connection works and their cost.
